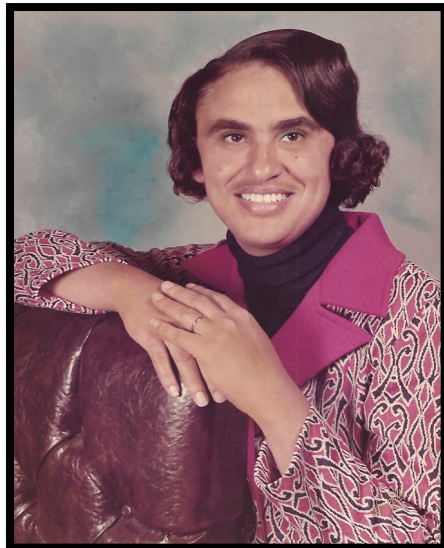
## Life Profile
