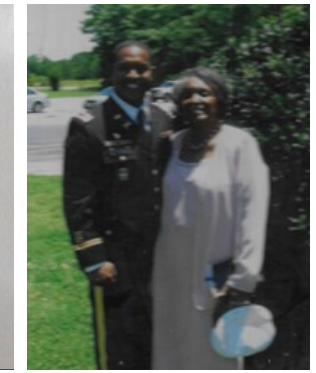

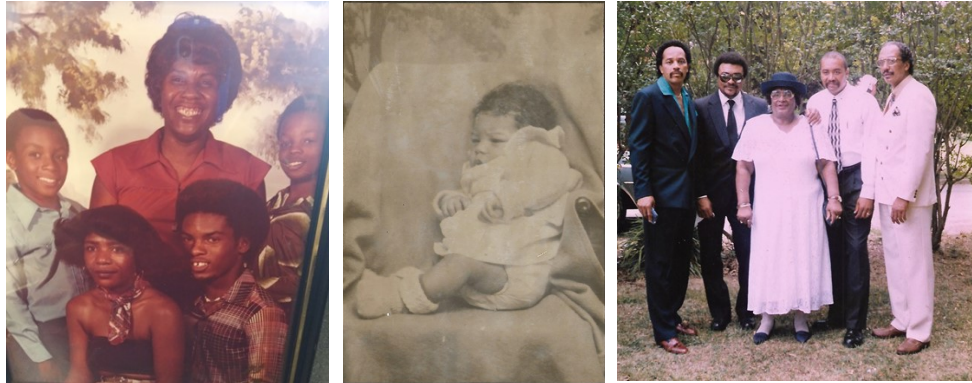
“I Just Went To Sleep”
