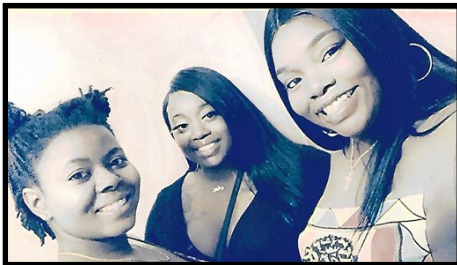

Life Profile

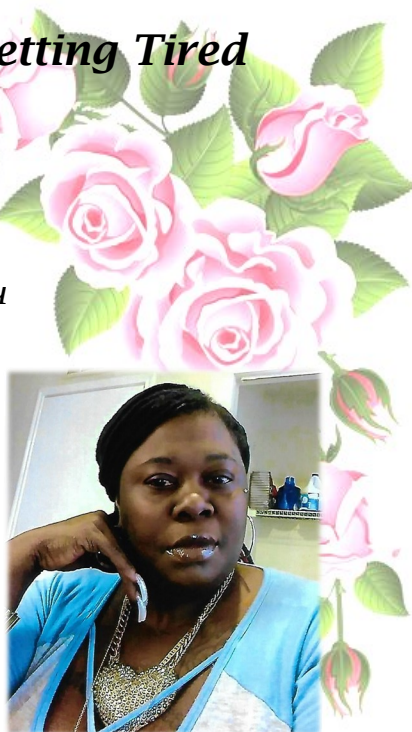

 He only takes the best.*

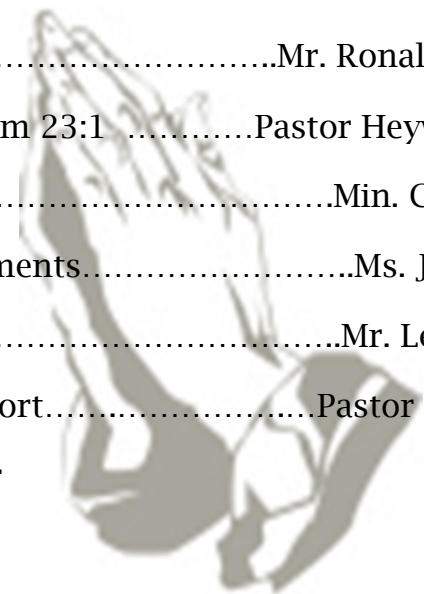
