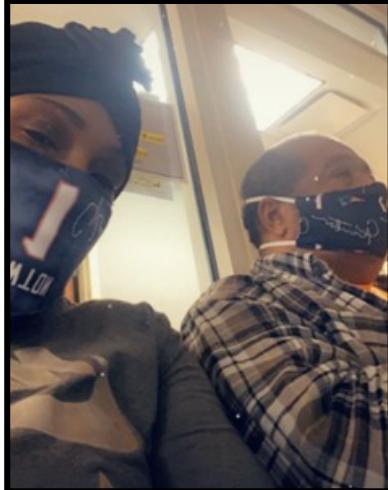

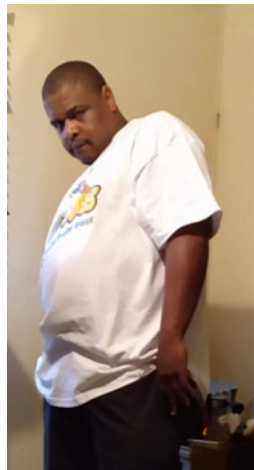

Sleep In Paradise *Grandpa's Gone To Heaven*

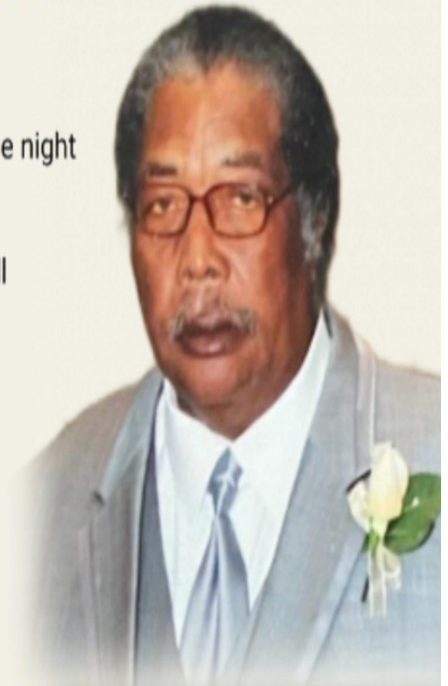
One quiet day the angels came
