to dry before the sun;*

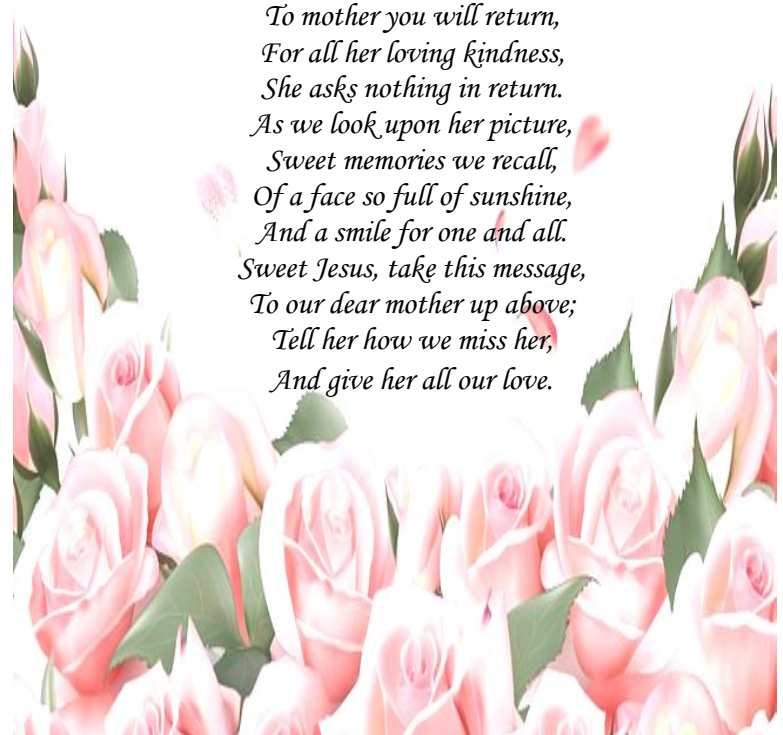
*Of happy memories that I leave

Martha also was preceded in death by her son Nathan D. Switzer.

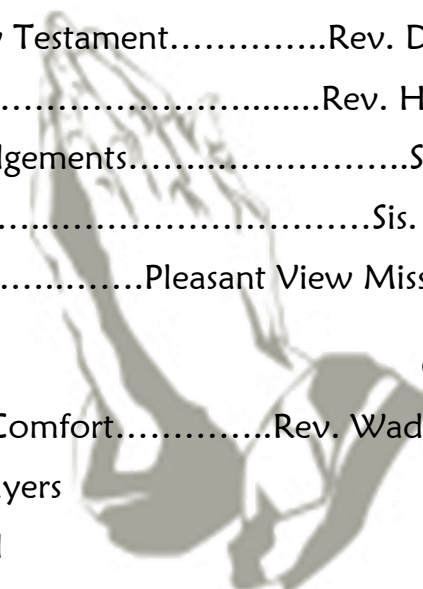
