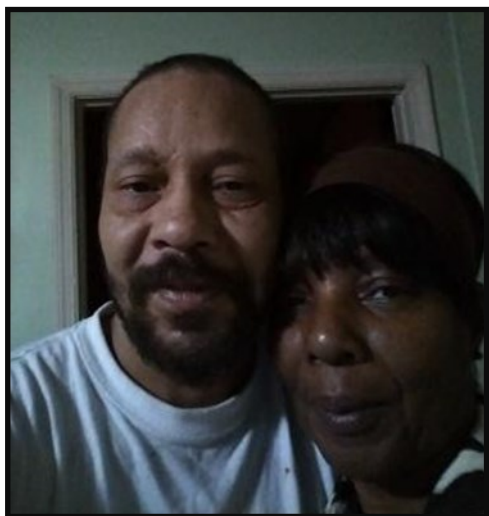
Life Profile
