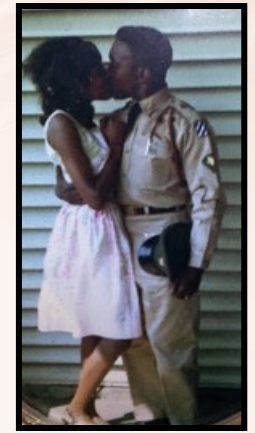

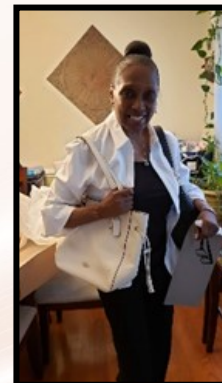


Remember Me
